Daily Mile 'Santa Run'

On **Friday 1st December** we will be participating in the Daily Mile 'Santa Run' where the children will wear something festive along with their PE uniform, we will meet at the Church Car Park at 8.30am to walk together as a whole school. Children will also walk/run the daily mile with their class in school.

From Monday 4th December to Fri 15th December we will be participating in the 'Journey to Santa' challenge where pupils compete to see who can carry out the most school journeys actively, in the run-up to Christmas. This can be all or part of the journey (eg. Park and ride/stride where you drive some of the way and park up, then cycle/walk/scoot the rest into school - ideal for families who live far away from school). Pupils receive one stamp for a morning journey and one for an afternoon journey. If a parent walks or cycles with them, they receive an extra stamp. We understand cycling or walking to school is not possible for every family and there will still
